- 2004: WHATWG
- 2008: HTML5 working draft W3C
- 2009: XHTML 2.0 Dropped
- 2014: HTML5 W3C standard

# History

- W3C: World Wide Web Consortium
  - Works on a snapshot of HTML5 living standard
- WHATWG: Web Hypertext Application Technology Working Group
  - Apple, Mozilla, Opera
  - Works on HTML

```

- Transitional:

```
<!DOCTYPE HTML PUBLIC "-//W3C//DTD HTML 4.01 Transitional//EN" "  
http://www.w3.org/TR/html4/loose.dtd">
```

- Frameset:

```
<!DOCTYPE HTML PUBLIC "-//W3C//DTD HTML 4.01 Frameset//EN" "  
http://www.w3.org/TR/html4/frameset.dtd">
```
